#### Fun & Fellowship Team

- <u>Kitchen</u> this person or people makes sure that the kitchen stays organized and uncluttered.
- 2. <u>Baptism and Picnic</u> this team puts together our Baptism and Picnic, setting up for the event and coming up with activities to get everyone involved.
- 3. <u>Funeral Dinners Coordinator</u> this person calls all the volunteers and coordinates the meal after the funeral service for people who lose loved ones
- Funeral Dinners Helper these people provide food and/or help with the dinner.
- 5. <u>Men's Basketball Coordinator</u> this person will oversee this outreach ministry on Sunday afternoons. This is an opportunity for fellowship, exercise and outreach; therefore, Christ-like attitude and behavior are very important.
- Men's Basketball Team Member

   this person participates on the basketball team.
- 7. <u>Parish Nurse Team</u> The first-aid volunteer will be responsible to render first aid as needed during church services, activities and events. This person must show a caring and concerned spirit in calming and ministering to individuals who need first aid and have some training in the medical field. These people must have training in the medical field.
- 8. <u>Softball Coach</u> this person will oversee our coed softball team and make sure to promote it and get as many people involved as possible.
- 9. **Softball Team Member** this person participates on the basketball team.
- 10. <u>Volleyball Coordinator</u>—this person will oversee the summer volleyball ministry that our church is involved in with other churches.
- 11. <u>Volleyball Team Member</u>— this person participates on the volleyball team (we have teams of all ages)

# **Hospitality Team**

- 1. <u>Coffee Team</u> this involves making sure the coffee area is supplied with coffee and cleaned up.
- <u>Head Greeter</u>—this person coordinates and leads the Greeter Ministry of the Church
- 3. <u>Greeter Team</u> these friendly people are stationed at the entry doors of the Children's Center and the Life Center greeting everyone who comes.
- Usher Team these people assist people in finding seats during our regular
  worship services and any special services, as well as distributing bulletins,
  passing the offering plates, and welcoming people as they enter the auditorium.

### **Hospitality Team** (cont)

 Welcome Center Team—these people work face to face with new attendees, distributing gifts at the Welcome Center, answering questions about our church, and being able to send people in the right direction during our regular worship services.

#### Outreach Team

- Community Group Leader this person would work with the Pastor of Community and Outreach Elder to ensure that their community group is building community within their community group and that the community group is doing outreach into their community.
- Local Outreach
   – these people will be responsible for putting together a brochure
   of all the local outreach opportunities people might be interested in. They are to
   work with the Community Group Leader to make sure each community group is
   doing at least two outreaches each year.
- 3. <u>Mission Support</u> these people will take care of our mission's board, keep in regular contact with our missionaries, and make recommendations on new missionaries to support.. They will also make recommendations for age appropriate mission trips.

### Spiritual Vibrancy Team

- 24 Hour Prayer Vigil Team these people schedule and oversee the three 24 hour prayer vigils we do each year. They are responsible for making sure the rooms are set-up, prayer requests are printed and distributed, and getting as many people signed up for the vigil as possible
- Adult Sunday School Superintendent this person makes sure all curriculum is ordered as needed, ensures that attendance is kept, and various other duties that come up as needed.
- 3. <u>Adult Teachers</u> these people lead classes and reach out to new attendees as requested by the Elder over spiritual vitality or one of the pastors. They need to decide if they want to lead a Sunday School class, a Wed. Night Prayer Group or a SEED Group.
- 4. <u>Altar Care Ministry</u> these people would be involved in being trained to pray with people during the prayer time.
- <u>Camp Meeting Team</u> this team is responsible to promote and encourage our congregation to be involved with our District's annual camp meeting.
- Emmaus Walk Coordinator this person promotes the Emmaus walk and works
  with those who have already gone to encourage others to go on this life-changing
  spiritual retreat.

## **SPIRITUAL VIBRANCY Team (cont)**

- 8. <u>Love Feast Team</u> these people oversee our yearly Love Feast (the Wed. before Easter) and make sure it is promoted and all the elements of the service happen to ensure the service is put together in a spiritually enriching way.
- 9. <u>Prayer Warrior</u> prays during one of our worship services to provide protection and seek the Lord's will for the service.
- 10. <u>Women's Ministry Team</u> these people work to promote and develop a women's ministry that builds relationships among our women and oversee events that challenge them spiritually.

#### **Worship Ministry Team**

- 1. <u>Decorations Team</u> this team oversees the various seasonal decorations to help beautify our worship area and church.
- 2. <u>Drama Team</u> members of the drama team meet weekly to prepare for upcoming dramas during the Sunday Worship Service and a variety of special events. They will regularly perform their memorized character part in front of the congregation.
- 3. <u>Interpreter for the Deaf</u> the interpreter for the deaf is responsible for interpreting messages, songs, announcements and other communication during church services and occasionally during special visits with deaf members.
- 4. <u>Multi-media Room Computer</u> these members will be trained in using Media Shout software used during our public services. Maker. General computer experience is a plus—training will be provided
- 5. <u>Multi-media Room</u> <u>Sound</u> these members need to be familiar with the operation of sound equipment including a sound board, amplifiers, microphones, patch cables, and other such equipment—training will be provided
- <u>Recording Ministry</u> these people record and distribute the sermon via CDs and Podcast. They also fill orders for previous series as they come in.
- 7. <u>Set-up and Tear Down Team</u> these people ensure that set-up and tear down for all events happens in a timely manner. They will work with the Worship Pastor to know what and when set-up and tear-down need to happen.
- 8. <u>Worship Team Instrumentalists</u> members of this team meet weekly to prepare worship music for the Sunday Worship Service and a variety of special events.
- Worship Team Vocalists members of this team meet weekly to prepare worship music for the Sunday Worship Service and a variety of special events.



- <u>Fun and Fellowship Ministry Team</u> this team is overseen by the Elder over Fun and Fellowship and ensures that the church is doing events to build relationships and foster community. They are responsible for making yearly recommendations to the Finance Team for budgeting in their area.
- <u>Hospitality Team</u> members of this team help Pleasant View remain a wonderful place to be by providing a welcoming environment.
- Outreach Ministry Team— this team is overseen by the Elder over Outreach and is responsible for making sure that our church is involved with local, state, national, and international outreach and making recommendations to the Finance Team for who we should be supporting financially.
- **Spiritual Vibrancy Ministry Team** This team is responsible for developing specific ministries such as discipleship, prayer ministries, etc to help our church develop a dynamic worship life corporately and individually. It is overseen by the Elder over Spiritual Vibrancy. They are responsible for making yearly recommendations to the Finance Team for budgeting in their area.
- **Worship Ministry Team** This team is responsible for developing specific ministries to help our church develop a dynamic worship life corporately and individually. It is overseen by the Director of Worship and the Elder over Worship. They are responsible for making yearly recommendations to the Finance Team for budgeting in their area.
